  - ACT composite test score of 15
  - Must obtain 6 hours of Christian Service Hours per semester starting in the ninth grade
  
- College Preparatory Track: (22 credits + one Bible credit per year in Christian School)
  - 4 credits Bible
  - 4 credits English
  - 4 credits Math Electives (Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, + an advanced math class)
  - 4 credits Social Studies (Geography/World Issues, World History, U. S. History, Government - ½, Economics - ½)
  - 3 credits Science (Biology, Physical Science, Chemistry)
  - 1 credit Another science is highly recommended to proceed to a four year college (Honors Physics, Honors Anatomy, Forensics)
  - ½ credit Health
  - ½ credit PE
  - 2 credits Foreign Lang. (Spanish I and Spanish II)
  - 1 credit Honors Spanish III or Speech
  - 1 credit Fine Arts Elective
  - 1 credit Electives
  - ACT composite test score of 16
  - Must obtain 6 hours of Christian Service Hours per semester starting in the ninth grade
