5. Because the Christian school supports and complements the Christian home and church during the child’s formative years. Daily devotions, prayer in the classroom, chapel services, and Christian friendships are examples of this support.
6. Because the Christian school believes in old fashioned Biblical methods of discipline and seeks to produce proper, consistent behavior.
