The above programs follow the regular school year calendar. Students entering the 3-year-old preschool program can begin when they turn three and must be potty-trained. The Transitional Kindergarten class is intended for students who will turn four by August 31st and Kindergarten is intended for students who will turn five by August 31st. Those students whose birthdates fall after these days may also be accepted. Please inquire at the school office.

# Payment plans include:

- (A) paid in full, due by August 1<sup>st</sup> \$100 discount
- (B) paid by semester, due by August 1<sup>st</sup> and January 1<sup>st</sup>
- (C) 10 month payments begin August 1<sup>st</sup>
- (D) 12 month payments begin June 1<sup>st</sup>

For those who choose to make monthly payments, those payments MUST be made to FACTS, a contractor to FCS for collecting and processing tuition and fees.

# **FINANCIAL POLICIES:**

# EARLY WITHDRAWAL FEE:

A \$750.00 withdrawal fee will apply for any student (Preschool – 12th) who withdraws between the time of enrollment/reenrollment and June 30th. For students withdrawing between July 1st and the end of the first semester, a fee of 50% of the remaining unearned tuition balance for the year is due.

For students withdrawing between the first day of the second semester and the end of the school year, a withdrawal fee of 100% of the remaining unearned tuition balance for the year is due.

All remaining unearned Student Resource and Technology Fees balance will also be owed after July 1<sup>st</sup>.

# FACTS TUITION:

**Friendship Christian School uses the FACTS tuition program.** FACTS is a tuition collection agency that works through an automated withdrawal system. For more information go to <u>www.factsmgt.com</u>

#### LATE FEES AND RETURNED CHECKS:

A late fee of \$20 is added to the student account if not paid within five days of the due date. A returned check results in a \$30 returned check fee to cover bank charges. If you have insufficient funds for a FACTS withdrawal, your account will be charged an additional \$30 by FACTS.

# **GENERAL FINANCIAL POLICIES:**

- 1. A student will not be enrolled in FCS if there is a previous financial obligation to another school. Before any student will be admitted to the school, all previous tuition, fees, financial obligations, etc. must be liquidated.
- 2. Any account that is outstanding 60 days after due date may cause the student to be suspended until payment is brought up to date.
- 3. The majority of the student textbooks are rentals for the year. Students will be charged for damaged books. It is advised to cover books according to the teacher's policies.
- 4. At the end of a semester, if there are any financial obligations, fees, late charges, unreturned books, unreturned laptops and chargers, unreturned uniforms, etc., the child will not be allowed to take his/her final examinations, participate in Kindergarten or High School graduation, or any other activity involving FCS. We will not report a grade for that semester or release student records for that student.
