Classes Offered

Our students begin with music class in preschool, choir in the 3rd grade, and Elementary band in 5th grade. Students can continue in middle school and high school in band and choir. Students begin art in elementary and can continue through high school. Speech is offered for high school students.

All HS students are required to have at least one Fine Arts credit to graduate. Each class counts as ½ credit.
