Snacks/Lunch

Activities

FCS Summer Camp offers activities that make our program unique. In order to form an appreciation of new experiences, all children are encouraged to participate in a wide range of activities. These include field trips to sites of interest, aerobic exercises, water activities, indoor/outdoor games, library time, and sports skills. Dress Code

Summer Camp clothing should be modest and appropriate for summer fun. No objectionable pictures or slogans can be worn on t-shirts.

BOYS

- Blue jeans or walking shorts*.
- Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times (tennis shoes are recommended).

GIRLS

- Girls may wear long shorts*, capris, non-form fitting pants, modest shirts or t-shirts.
- No tank tops, halters, or leggings
- Shoes must be worn at all times (tennis shoes are recommended).

*Shorts should be modest in length when sitting. A good way to measure this is to make sure the shorts come to within 3 inches of the crease in the back of the knee.

Personal Items

Personal items must be labeled with the child's name, and the teacher should be made aware of any item.
