FCS HOUSE SYSTEM

Overview

The house system is designed to foster community and relationships within the student body. Every high school student will be randomly divided into one of four houses. Once assigned a house, they will remain in that house until they graduate. Each house will have two student representatives helping to lead monthly meetings and competitions. Each student can earn points for his house through various opportunities built into school (athletics, fine arts, academics, service hours). The points will be totaled throughout the year. The house with the most points will be named House Champion at the end of the year.

Purpose

- > **Compete together** Houses will compete in various competitions throughout the year. The goal of these competitions is to bring students together and highlight the unique talents that God has given each of them.
- > **Grow together-** During each house meeting, students will be given a challenge from God's word and an opportunity to discuss how they can apply God's Word to their lives.
- > **Serve together** Following Christ's example of serving others, students will be presented with service opportunities that can be accomplished together.
